What is TSA?

The Technology Student Association (TSA) is a national, non-profit organization of 250,000 middle and high school students engaged in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). Since TSA was chartered in 1978, almost 4,000,000 student members have participated through challenging competitions, leadership opportunities, and community service. Currently, more than 2,300 schools are affiliated with TSA nationwide.
